Once you have committed to attend an activity, each chairperson and the venue is counting on your attendance.





Another yummy recipe from card group! Linda Lonnquist's soft chewy molasses cookies Ingredients

- 2 1/4 C flour
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1 1/2 tsp each ground cinnamon, ground ginger
- 1/2 tsp ground cloves
- 1/4 tsp allspice
- 1/4 tsp each salt & pepper
- 3/4 C unsalted butter, softened
- 1/3 C packed dark brown sugar
- 1/2 C granulated sugar
- 1/2 C light or dark **molasses**
- 1 large egg yolk,
- 1 tsp pure vanilla extract
- 1/3 granulated sugar

Instructions

- 1. Whisk the flour, baking soda, ginger, cinnamon, cloves, allspice, pepper salt together until combined.
- 2. In a large bowl using a handheld or stand mixer fitted with a paddle attachment, beat the butter and both sugars together on high speed until creamy and combined, about 2 minutes. Add egg yolk and vanilla and mix. Add the molasses and beat until combined. Scrape down the sides and bottom of the bowl as needed.
- 3. On low speed, slowly mix the dry ingredients into the wet ingredients until combined. The cookie dough will be slightly sticky. Stir to check for any flour pockets
- 4. Preheat oven to 375°F Line two large baking sheets with parchment paper
- 5. Roll cookie dough, 1 Tablespoon each, into balls. Roll each in granulated sugar and arrange 2 inches apart on the baking sheets. Bake for 11–12 minutes or until edges appear set.
- 6. Remove from the oven and allow cookies to cool on the baking sheet for 5 minutes before transferring to a wire rack to cool completely.
